- Ensure alignment of activity with the LHIN's strategic plan and priorities. Make recommendations and propose options with an eye to opportunities for increased alignment of LHIN and health service provider activities with LHIN strategy.
- Work with internal and external stakeholders to formulate key questions, analyze information, make recommendations and identify options/solutions to local health care issues that may be complex and sensitive in nature. Work with internal and external stakeholders to implement recommendations.
- Lead the development and execution of plans related to the LHIN's priority of increasing "value and affordability" in the health care system

- Working with other LHIN staff, ensure alignment of health service provider accountability agreements with LHIN priorities and goals

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Masters degree in health administration, health planning, public health, business administration or similar, or equivalent combination of education and experience
- Demonstrated understanding of health issues, priorities and needs. Clear understanding of the broader trends in health care policy and system development.
- Knowledge of the Ontario health care system
- Five or more years of related experience in a health care provider setting, service planning entity, Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care or equivalent
- Demonstrated experience working effectively in partnership with broad range of individuals and organizations of diverse backgrounds within the health care sector.
- Experience in analysis of health care issues across multiple sectors.
- Ability to multi-task with strong attention to detail within a fast-paced environment with changing priorities
- Superior written and oral communication skills
- Demonstrated project management skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills, to work effectively with other LHIN staff, and to liaise with health service providers
