Responses to Submitted Questions – May 12, 2010

Funding- Rental Units

Q1. I would like to enquire about housing families with a parent dealing with addiction issues, specifically, will there be rent supplement available for 2 2-bedroom units among the 24 housing units we are proposing to operate?

The determination of rent supplement funding is the responsibility of the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC). The MOHLTC will determine the amount of rent supplement funding to be provided to health service providers.

Q2. What is the amount of the rent supplement per unit?

Rent supplement funding will be determined by the MOHLTC.

Q3. Are there additional funds for start up costs?

There are no additional funds for start up costs anticipated.

Q4. Is there the possibility of capital costs for building improvement?

Funding for capital improvements to buildings is the responsibility of the MOHLTC. Health service providers can submit a request for capital funding directly to the MOHLTC.

Funding- Support Services

Q5. Is the support funding \$ amount a fixed amount per FTE (i.e. \$85,000/FTE)? If so, how much?

Toronto Central LHIN understands that the funding for support services is based on a fixed amount in the amount of approximately \$85,000 per eight supportive housing units. The final amount of funding will be based on the approved allocation received by Toronto Central LHIN from the MOHLTC.

Target Population

Q6. Will Problem Gamblers be able to access the addictions housing?

No- the allocated units are designated for people with problematic substance use.
